Pay-it-Forward (PIF) Event and Children's Day Celebration

We are excited to announce that our school will be hosting the annual Pay-it-Forward (PIF) charity event this upcoming Sunday, 29 September 2024. Many of our students and staff will be actively involved, demonstrating care and compassion for the less privileged in our community.

In recognition of their efforts, all students, except for those in Primary 6, will be given a break on Monday, 30 September 2024, and do not need to report to school.

As for Children's Day celebration, the school is organizing a special excursion for all Primary School students to **Singapore Bird Paradise on Thursday, 3 October 2024**. The school will provide the transportation to and from the destination on that day. It is compulsory for your child/ward to participate in this event. However, if you have a valid reason to disallow your child/ward from participating in this activity, he/she is still required to attend school and stay in the library throughout the entire duration of the activity. Please take note that all Primary School students **do not** attend school on **Friday, 4 October 2024**, as it is a Children's Day holiday.
