### School Updates (Term 2)

Thank you for playing an active role in keeping San Yu Adventist School (SYAS) and the community safe in the midst of this pandemic. We seek your continuous cooperation to ensure a smooth educational experience for all students.



#### 1. Drop Off/ Pick Up of Students


We would like parents/guardians who drop off and pick up their children/ wards to show consideration for our neighbours along Chancery Lane and Novena Regency by refraining from blocking their driveways with vehicles during school arrival/ dismissal times. In addition, parents/ guardians do not need to reach SYAS too early to wait for their children/wards as teachers will only release students on time.


#### 2. Travel during the June School Holidays

A few of our students have indicated their intention to go back to their home countries during the annual June school holidays. Parents/ guardians are to take note of the following if their children/ wards intend to travel out of Singapore:

- Parents/ guardians should refer to the Singapore Immigrations and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) website <https://safetravel.ica.gov.sg/stpl/requirements-and-process> for current border restrictions and applications to enter Singapore.
- Ensure that the student returns to SYAS on Monday, 28 June, to start Term 3.
- Inform SYAS via email the student's country and dates of travel.
- Update student travel declaration plan (Term 2: May-June School Holiday 2021) via the ASKnLearn portal, <https://lms.asknlearn.com/syas>

o Look out for the  to edit your travel declaration.

o Remember to check against the checkbox "I declare that all the information entered here is correct and accurate as of the time of submission of this declaration.\*" and lastly, click on the  to update your travel declaration.

Due to the volatile pandemic situation, we strongly encourage our Primary 6 and Secondary 4 students to stay in Singapore during the coming June holidays. We are concerned that our graduating students' learning will be affected in the event of sudden border closures, either in students' home countries and/or in Singapore. Students might not be able to travel back to Singapore to start Term 3 successfully.

#### 3. Visit to the Doctor

Most, if not all, students have exercised social responsibility by washing their hands regularly and putting on their masks properly to keep sickness at bay. We want to reiterate the importance of visiting the doctor when one is unwell, especially with the onset of flu-like symptoms. Let us all remain vigilant and keep one another safe.
