#### 3. New Computer Education Subject for Primary 3 to 6 Students

fundamental computer skills, coding, and digital literacy, equipping our students with the knowledge and abilities needed to navigate and thrive in an increasingly digital world. This subject will be part of the regular curriculum starting in 2025.

- 4. Upgraded Premium AI-Powered Marking System for P5 to S4 Written Compositions**  
Upper primary and secondary school students will get instant feedback on written English compositions when an upgraded premium marking system powered by artificial intelligence is rolled out on the school learning portal in 2025. ### **New Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board Regulation Pertaining to PSLE and AEIS**

This is a gentle reminder from SEAB that all PSLE private candidates will not be allowed to take AEIS from 2023 onwards. Technically, all PSLE private candidates will not be allowed to sign up for two examinations within a year. Thus, do not sign up for AEIS examinations in 2025 if your child/ward is eligible to take the PSLE next year.
